You will need:

- ★ Newspapers and magazines

You may choose from the following tasks. Feel free to complete them all!

Treasure Map

Draw a large joined shape (this is your island). Add the following: Forrest, lakes, beaches, coves, mountain range, village, swamp, rivers. Then design a X marks the spot treasure trail. Name your island with lots of cool “Pirate-y” names, like “Dead Man’s Cove.”

Colour Collage

On a large black kinder square create a collage page. Find a selection of newspapers and magazines. Choose a popular colour, carefully cut out pictures of the same colour. Stick them down on the paper, do not leave any gaps.

Create with googly eyes

Cut out and glue down the photocopied googly eyes on an A4 white page. Using pencils, textas or pens create the most amazingly scary or beautiful creature you can! Don’t forget the background – could your creature be underwater, in outer space, in a jungle or desert wasteland?

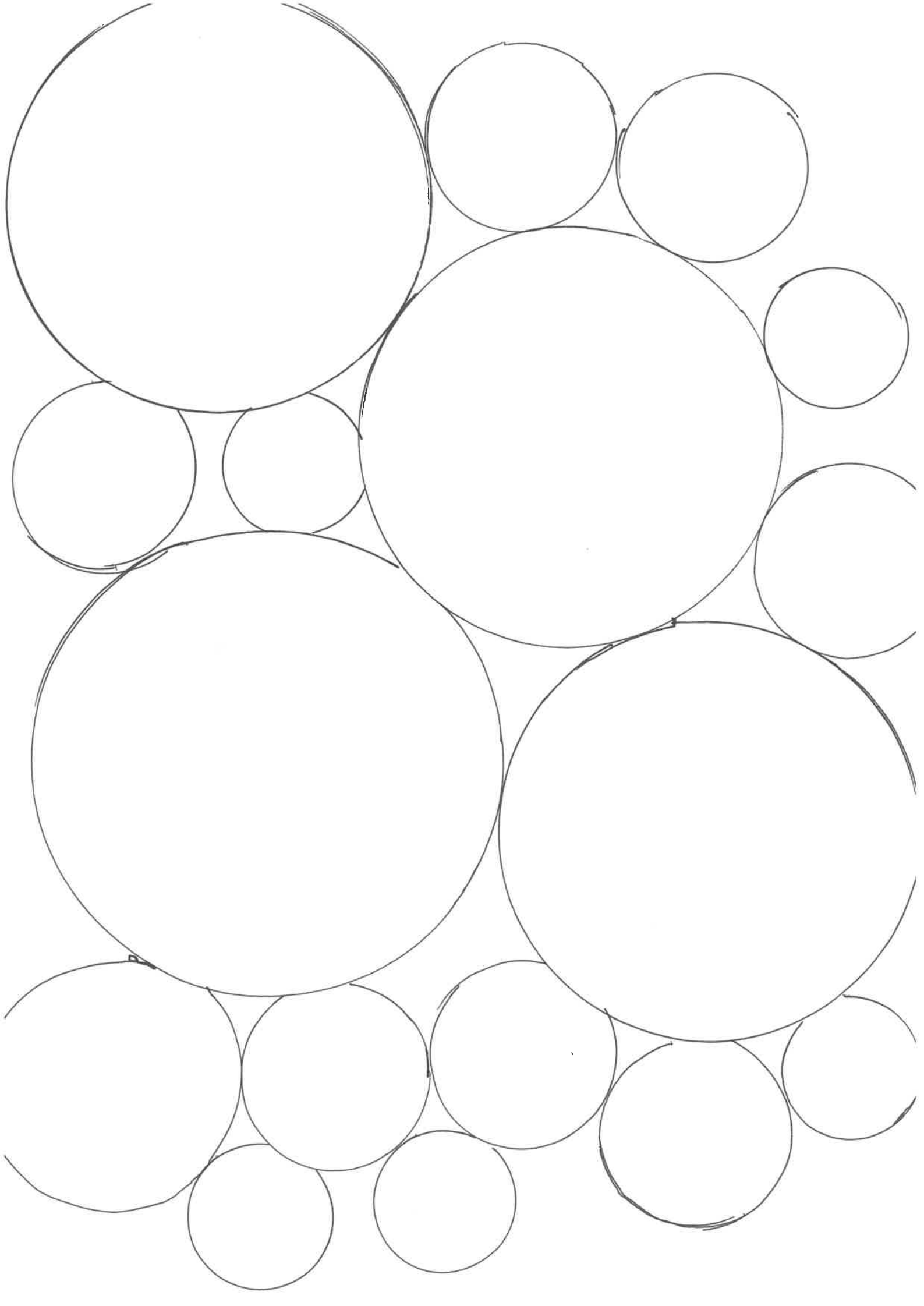
Pattern Play

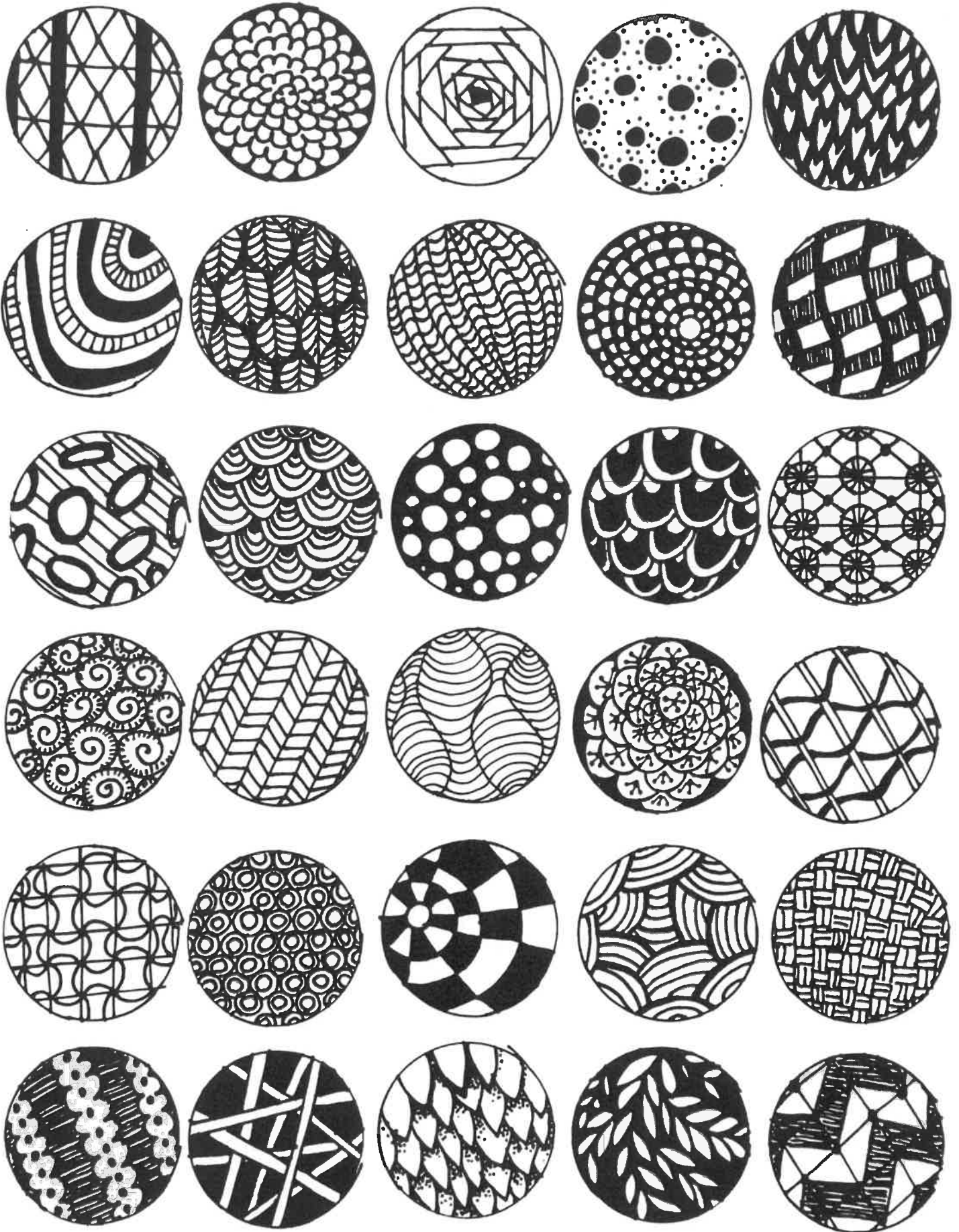
Using the A4 page with the circles, fill it in with a variety of different zentangle patterns. See the example page for ideas.
